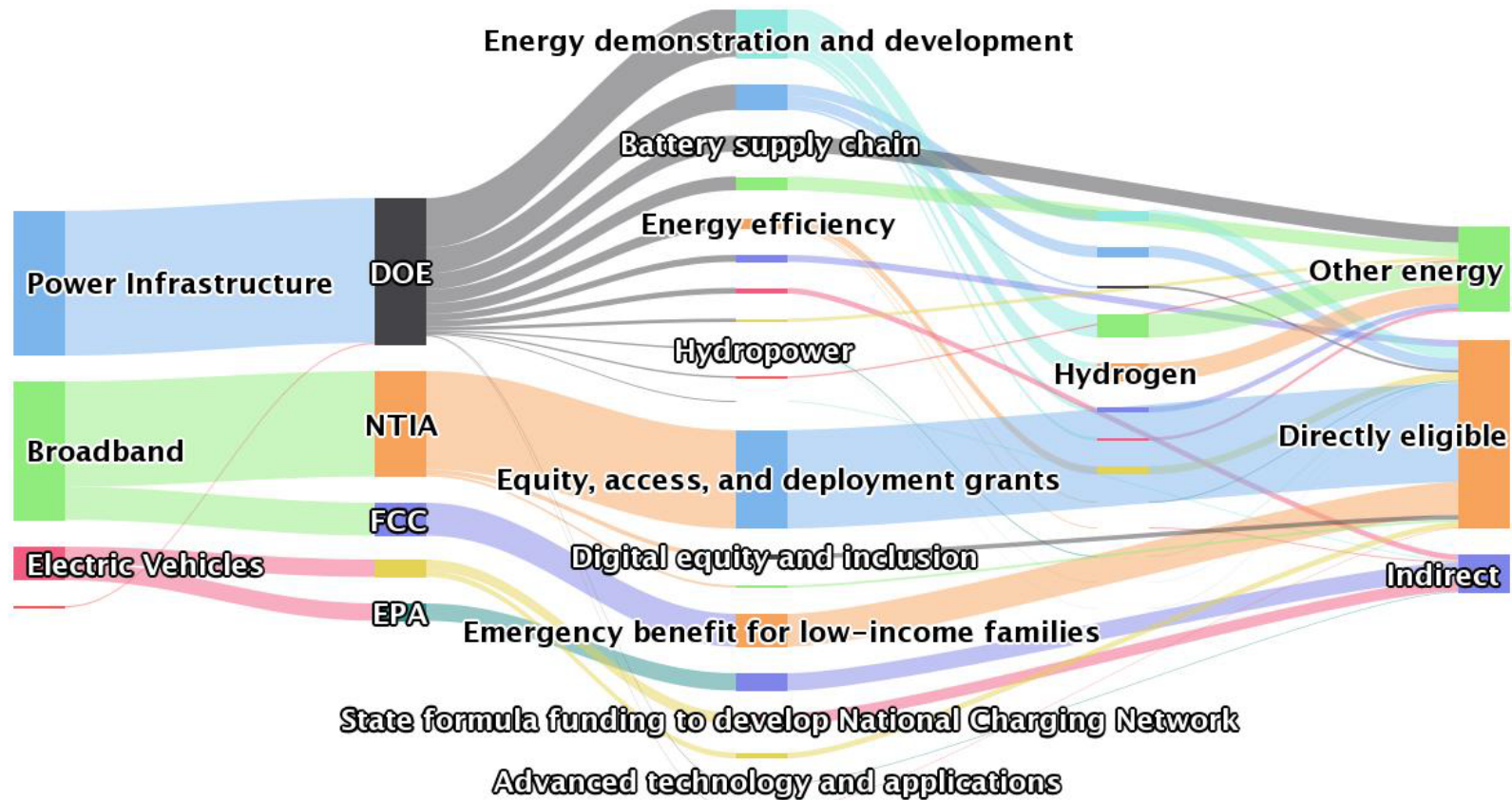


APPA's Strategic Priorities
