

Ray D. Anderson

Ray Anderson was appointed as City Manager for the City of Norway by the Norway City Council in February of 2002. Anderson was originally hired by the City of Norway in August of 1999 as Utility Director responsible for managing the city's electric generation (hydro)/distribution, communications (video, VoiP, High Speed Internet with fiber/copper), water, sewer, and public works departments. Mr. Anderson holds a Bachelor's of Science Degree in Civil Engineering from Michigan Technological University and a Master's in Business Administration from Olivet Nazarene University.

During Ray's 21 year tenure with the City of Norway, he has managed numerous utility projects including a major retrofit of their Sturgeon Falls Hydroelectric Plant, upgrades to miles of out of date electric distribution lines, a major upgrade to the cable plant and headend, as well as major water and sewer replacement projects. Anderson also managed other public works projects such as street reconstruction and the construction of a new city hall and fire hall during his tenure. All of this while still managing the day to day operations of the city as well as numerous contract negotiations between labor and council.

Prior to working for the City of Norway, Anderson worked as a project engineer and project manager for CBI Services Incorporated. His projects were located both domestic and abroad as he worked projects in the industrial construction sectors.
