

Jonathan Tauber is the Director of Strategy Policy and Advocacy at Consumers Energy, responsible for leading the company's legislative and regulatory policy research team. He oversees development of the company's state and federal energy regulatory policy and strategy, including regional transmission and market development, distributed resources, resource adequacy and decarbonization.

Previously, Jon served as Managing Senior Corporate Counsel at the Midcontinent Independent System Operator ("MISO"). In this role, Jon provided legal advice and strategic guidance on regulatory and stakeholder member initiatives to enhance regional electricity markets, facilitate long-term regional planning and promote resource adequacy.

Prior to joining MISO, Jon served in several roles at the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("PUCO"), initially as an attorney examiner and administrative law judge presiding over electric regulatory and power siting proceedings. Later, Jon was a Deputy Director and appointed as the Ohio Federal Energy Advocate, leading an office responsible for advocating on behalf of the state's retail electric customers at federal regulatory and administrative agencies.
