Dr. Destenie Nock is an Associate Professor at Carnegie Mellon University and the CEO of Peoples Energy Analytics, a company that uses data analytics to identify energy affordability challenges and support more equitable utility programs. Her work focuses on energy affordability, energy justice, utility regulation, and the ways households cope when energy costs become unaffordable. Dr. Nock served as an expert witness in Massachusetts Department of Public Utilities docket D.P.U. 24-15, where she wrote the Commonwealth's definition of energy affordability and was instrumental in the proceeding that led to the adoption of tiered low-income discount rates. Her research and applied analytics have supported regulatory proceedings, utility planning, and affordability interventions across the electric and gas sectors.
